

# 5 Things to Do after Submitting Your Fidelity Application

It's easy to fall into the wait, wonder, and worry trap after submitting your application. Instead, use that energy to set yourself up for success with these go-to tips.

## 1. Find Your Fidelity Why



Write why you want to work for Fidelity.



Be clear, brief, and authentic.



Explore Fidelity's website and social media to get inspired.

## ★ 2. Be an Interview STAR

Use the STAR method when preparing for an interview to answer individual questions with a clear narrative.

Letter	What it means	Real-world example
Situation	Set the scene and provide any context	"I worked in a restaurant as a server."
Task	Explain your role and responsibilities.	"I was responsible for training new hires."
Action	Describe what you did and why.	"I gave them insider tips about how to give exceptional service and be more efficient so that we could work better as a team."
Result	Report what you made happen.	"We decreased customer complaints by 10% and improved our Yelp rating by one star."

## ♥ 3. Give LinkedIn Some Love ♥

Your résumé and LinkedIn profile should match to present a unified picture of you and your experience.

Connect with hiring managers and recruiters if you have their info, so you can start networking.

Follow Fidelity and other industry thought leaders. You can bring up posts or articles you've read in the interview.

Keep an eye out for news related to your role to stay informed about the latest trends and to leave a positive impression regarding your industry knowledge.

## 💬 4. Engage Appropriately

Be the Goldilocks of engagement—not too much or too little:

- Respond to recruiters promptly and succinctly.
- Wait one to two weeks before following up.
- Keep it to one communication method.
- Ask for feedback.



## 5. Thank-you Prep

- Have cards and stamps on hand so you can send a quick thank-you after an interview (optional).
- Send a short email after a call with a recruiter or an interview to express your thanks.
- Briefly reiterate your Fidelity why and what makes you excited about the opportunity.
